

CASE REPORT ON THE USE OF AN ADSORBENT WOUND DRESSING WITH ACTIVE COAL AND SILVER* IN POST TRAUMATIC WOUNDS

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Aim: To present the results of utilization of an adsorbent wound dressing with active coal and silver in the treatment of post traumatic wounds with large substance loss.

Methods: Two patients were considered who both had substantial postraumatic skin loss on their legs. The adsorbent wound dressing was evaluated for the effectiveness, antibacterial activity and capability of odour control.

Discussion: The use of this wound dressing enabled restoration of the skin loss in the patients, with less changes than with the customary dressing, and with very good infection and pain control.
