Corinne Scicluna is a Senior Lecturer at the University of Malta and is the coordinator of the Master's degree in Specialist pathways including the skin and wound care pathway. She was the first Tissue Viability Specialist Nurse who led this service in Malta. Corinne is president and founder of the Maltese Association of Skin and wound Care, and Chair of the Foundation of Nurse Specialists Europe (FoNSE) and is the former president of the International Skin Care Nursing Group. She also represents Malta on the International Diabetic Foot Group, the teacher's network in the European Wound Management Association, the Commonwealth Wound Care Resource Alliance and is a European member of the World Union of Wound Healing Societies. Corinne was a Senior Nursing Manager at Mater Dei Hospital and managed the Child and Development Assessment Unit at St Luke's Hospital.

She was the president of the Nurses' Association of Malta prior to its amalgamation with the Malta Union of Midwives and Nurses (MUMN). She was the chair of the Commonwealth Nursing Federation for the European Region between 2002-2007.

Corinne obtained a Diploma and Degree in Nursing from the University of Malta, and a Master's of Science Degree in Wound Healing and Tissue Repair from the University of Cardiff, UK and has been awarded a PhD from Bournemouth University, UK in 2017.
